



Archaeology: from North Carolina to Hradec Králové

This project will explore basic archaeological concepts and methodology in English, and will include real examples of archaeology in your own city!

The goal of this project is to understand methods that archaeologists use to survey sites, excavate, catalogue artifacts, map sites and make research conclusions, all in English, and to see past many misconceptions about archaeologists and what they do. David will explain his experience as an archaeological assistant in North Carolina and important vocabulary, and then the group will meet with archaeologists here in Hradec Králové to learn about their findings and see examples of artifacts/a site in real life. The secondary goal of this project is to compare archaeology between more anthropological sites in North America to historical sites here in Europe.
